State ID cards \$5 each, Form 2's due June 15th. Must declare or drop teams by April 1st. Online registration opens January 6. Insurance deadline is May 15th. Roster deadline for tournaments is July 1.

Facility Needs for 2020: Roll infield + outfield x2, paint dugouts, stands and concession stands, slats in outfield fence or new fence/wall, measure, string and cut all grass lines, mix infield dirt w/turface, cut outfield grass shorter, fence to enclose facility, level and roll bathing cages, use OMNI turf from tennis courts, add tee area at batting cages, shade grand stands, add bleachers, remove fence from c dugouts, enclose c dugouts, put home plates in bullpen mounds at c field, batter eye for both fields, trophy display case, "P" logo cut in grass, windscreen, 4 wheeler.

2020 budget will need to get set. Will base it upon previous years.

Cory working on getting fence underwritten by corporate sponsors for tournament or discussion on SWI getting us a good deal.

Cory reported on gun raffle (Rocky Mtn Sports) 20 guns - \$11,400. May need to drop down to 15 guns instead. Easy to work with as they will do paperwork etc. Cayde asked Cory to explore other options as well. Discussion on starting the drawing on the 1st day of state tournament. May start selling gun raffle tickets at taco dinner.

Cory to draft a mock up banner commitment form letter. \$350 1st year, \$250 next 2 years.

Trent to head up scoreboard and stats committee.

Joe Gardner is the head umpire.

Cayde renewed website for 3 years.

Vision West getting fan gear site going.

Cory reported on meeting with Scott McKenzie and Chase Kistler with PHS. Tyler England and Colin Queen were also at meeting representing Powell American Legion Baseball. The football camp dates were provided, and most HS camps are held the 2nd week in June. The PHS reps stated that their camps are not mandatory. Basketball open gyms moved to the mornings.
